INTERSCHOOL SPORTS TEAM SELECTION POLICY

1. Purpose

To define the eligibility criteria and procedure for selection of inter school sports teams.

2. Policy Objective

To be eligible for selection in the Howrah A and Howrah B Southern Primary School Sports Association inter-school sports teams, students must attend and compete in the Howrah Primary School carnivals.

Should a student be unable to compete in an event at a school based carnival, they will be ineligible to represent the school at Interschool level in that event

In the event that a school based carnival is cancelled, the P.E teacher will time students at the earliest possible time and use the timed results to select the teams.

3. Requirements

3.1 ATHLETICS SELECTION

Teams will be selected based on timed results taken from the school carnival and races prior to the carnival.

100m and 200m events will be run in heats and timed during the school carnival.

The Grade 6 vortex event will be measured during the carnival. The top ten vortex places re-throw with the P.E teacher to determine final results.

400m, 800m and 1500m events will be timed during recess or lunch races prior to the carnival. The Grade 6 Long Jump is measured with the P.E teacher during class time.

3.2 SWIMMING SELECTION

Races will be swum in heats and the teams selected based on student's times from the school carnival.

3.3 CROSS COUNTRY SELECTION

Teams will be selected on 'place' across the finish line from the school carnival.

First to sixth place will be selected for the Howrah A team.

Seventh to twelfth place will be selected in the Howrah B team.

In the case of a tie for sixth place, results from P.E lessons will be taken into consideration.

3.4 TRIATHLON

Students enter the interschool triathlon on a volunteer basis and fund their own entry.

School sports uniforms will be provided on the day of the carnival.
